Fees : Rs. 10,000

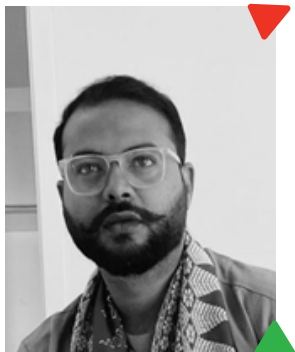
